Cook, stirring constantly. Heat to boiling. Let boil for one minute. Stir in Pastry for 9 inch 2 crust pie 1 3/4 cup chicken broth (1 can chicken broth) 2¹/₂- 3 cups cut-up chicken or turkey (precooked rotisserie chicken works well)

chicken/turkey and vegetables. Prepare pastry. Ease into 9 x 9 x 2 inch pan. Pour mixture in pan. Put square pastry over mixture and flute edges. Cut steam holes in top. Bake 35 minutes, or until golden brown. For best results, vote for Jay Ledbetter for Coroner.

Currently, the Coroner's office is only open 7-4, and closed over lunch and weekends. The Driver's License office does better than that. Jay Ledbetter will extend office hours for the convenience of the public. Public service is the point of this office, not as a convenient place for the Coroner to rake-in more of our tax dollars.
